## Helpful Tips when completing homework

1. **Writing letters** - In our curriculum we teach writing letters a specific way. To help reinforce this, please use the letter verbalizations I use in class. You can find these verbalizations on my class website:

2. **A little goes a LONG way!**

Try to keep homework to no longer than 20 minutes each night. Some students will want to rush through the packet to get it done. I would prefer you do a little each night. Feel free to rip the pages out of the packet so they only see what they should work on each night. At the end of the week you can send them all back in or just the signature page.

-If they get tired before 15 minutes, then take a break! It's better to get 5 quality minutes out of them instead of forcing 15 minutes of work.
