

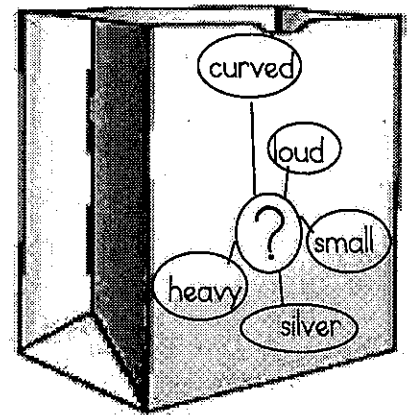
Star of the Week

Every student will have the opportunity to be "Star of the Week" once during the school year. A schedule will be sent home the first week of school listing the students in alphabetical order and gives the week in which each child will be the "Star." The Friday before the week it is your son or daughter's turn, I will send home the plastic estimation jar and the "Star of the Week" questionnaire. Please sit down with your child and fill in his or her responses to the statements.

During the week we will follow this schedule:

Monday: Return the questionnaire and send in photos; we create the "Star of the Week" bulletin board.

Tuesday: Bring in a Bubble Bag! Choose something special and place it in a bag. On the outside of the bag draw or attach a diagram like the one shown and use adjectives to describe the mystery object inside. The class try to guess what is in the bag after hearing the clues. Remind your child it is a surprise and not to tell his or her friends what is inside!

Wednesday: Return the estimation jar. The jar should be filled with small items from home (for example: bouncy balls, buttons, paper clips, erasers, etc.) Count how many items are in the container (no more than 100), write it on a piece of paper, fold it, and tape it to the lid of the jar. The estimation jar will be passed around the classroom and every student will have a chance to guess how many items are inside. The items will be returned to you. Due to the district policy, please do not include edible items.

Thursday: Share a story about YOU! Have a family member or friend write down a true story about you to share with the class. It might be about the day you were born, something special you did, or a proud accomplishment! Bring the story in to share with your classmates.

Friday: A family member or special friend is welcome to come in and bring a favorite story to read to the students at the end of the day. ***Please note, if your child will be going home with anyone other than the custodial parent (grandparent, aunt, etc.), there must be a written note stating permission and signed by the parent in order for the office to allow your child to go!*
